## **Helpful Tips for Nominations**

Please provide plenty of background information on the nominee and their accomplishments. This helps the selection committee make their decision.

Nominees are judged on their contribution to an environmentally healthy watershed, demonstrating long term benefits and cooperation with partners, groups and agencies. Nominations should include enough information about who the nominee is and the impact of their accomplishment.

Include any additional information you feel will support the nomination, such as photos, testimonial letters, media stories, etc.

Each response should be detailed but must not exceed 500 words. The selection committee will make their decision based on the completeness and clarity of the nomination.

## **Nomination Information**

1. Please provide a short biographical sketch of the nominee. Include information on education, memberships in clubs/organizations, and other awards received if applicable.

2. Describe how the individual/group has contributed to the conservation of natural resources within the Long Point Region watershed. Types of work eligible for the award include erosion control, stream improvement, wetlands conservation, woodlot management/reforestation, fish and wildlife improvement, conservation education, financial donations in support of conservation work, and/or any other work contributing to the conservation of the natural resources within the Long Point Region watershed.

3. Describe the success of the project or contribution to date. What makes the accomplishment special? How did it improve the health of the Long Point Region watershed? Is it effective, well designed and maintained?

4. Describe any special circumstances (i.e. effort, expense, number of years involved) that make the project or contribution even more noteworthy.

5. Are you aware of any further projects or contributions the nominee is planning to undertake in the future?

## **Supporting Material**

As part of the Long Point Conservation Stewardship Award nomination process, we ask those nominating an individual or group to submit photographs, newspaper clippings, reports or other material, if applicable. These materials are not mandatory but are strongly encouraged as they help to understand the scope of the nominee's achievements.
