

Leighton and Betty Brown Conservation Scholarship

2024 Application Form:

The Lee Brown Marsh Management Committee, in conjunction with Long Point Region Conservation Authority, has awarded the Leighton and Betty Brown Conservation Scholarship annually since 2007. If no suitable applicants are available in a given year, no scholarship will be awarded and the money will remain in the scholarship fund.

In 2024, one (1) \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to an eligible graduating high school student.

The scholarship recognizes graduating high school students who have achieved academic excellence and have distinguished themselves in extracurricular activities, environmental community service and volunteer activities. The successful applicants will be continuing their education at a recognized Canadian educational institution to study conservation, environment, resources management and/or related fields.

Scholarship Criteria:

The conservation scholarship award is open to students who:

- Reside within the Long Point Region watershed.
- Are currently attending their final year of high school.
- Have maintained a strong academic average.
- Have a demonstrated record of participation, leadership or volunteerism in promoting conservation and environmental awareness.
- Entering first year of full-time, undergraduate study in a Canadian university or college.
- Continuing education at a post secondary level in a conservation or environmental related course of study. This may include, but not limited to, forestry, biology, geography, geology, fish and wildlife, ecology, environmental engineering.
- Are not an employee or immediate family member of employees or directors of the Long Point Region Conservation Authority.
