BIG OTTER CREEK SUB-WATERSHED – EROSION CONTROL PROGRAM – EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Erosion is a significant problem in the Big Otter Creek sub-watershed and causes soil and nutrient loss, decreases workable farmland, damages farm equipment, decreases crop yields, and negatively impacts both aquatic and terrestrial ecosystems.

With funding support from the Canada Water Agency's Great Lakes Freshwater Ecosystem Initiative, the Long Point Region Conservation Authority has developed an erosion control cost sharing program in the Big Otter Creek sub-watershed to encourage farmers to address erosion problems on their agricultural land.

Under the program, grants covering 80% of the project cost, up to a maximum of \$15,000, are available to support a variety of erosion control techniques (note, the grant rate can increase if there is low project uptake). To apply, please send the completed expression of interest to the address above, c/o Paul Gagnon, Lands & Waters Supervisor. They can also be emailed to watercare@lprca.on.ca

Once received, a site visit will be set up to discuss the erosion problem and possible solutions. If the landowner is interested in undertaking a project, LPRCA staff can design the erosion control project for a fee of \$350.00, or the landowner can get a qualified person to design the project.
