Conservation Ontario Class Environmental Assessment

Teeterville Dam

The Study: The Long Point Region Conservation Authority (LPRCA), through their consultant Montrose Environmental (Montrose) (formerly Matrix Solutions) is undertaking a Conservation Ontario Class Environmental Assessment (CO Class EA) for the Teeterville Dam, located within the Hamlet of Teeterville, in Norfolk County. A Dam Safety Review (DSR) of the structure, commissioned by the LRPCA and completed in 2016, categorized the structure as having a “Low Hazard Potential” for both Sunny Day and Flood conditions. While minor issues were identified in regard to the earthen embankment portion of the dam, the concrete control dam elements failed to meet standard safety criteria and represent a risk of failure.

The LPRCA is completing this CO Class EA to assess various options to addressing the structural deficiencies identified in the DSR, and to meet their requirements with respect to water management, public safety, dam failure, natural heritage, fish and wildlife and recreational considerations. The project is being carried out under the guidance of the CO Class EA for Remedial Flood and Erosion Control Works document and, as such, includes a thorough characterization of the project environment and a broad program of consultation.

Public Information Centre: A key component of the EA process is consultation with interested stakeholders (public, landowners and agencies). A second Public Information Centre (PIC) is planned to share the study background, explain the EA process, outline existing environmental conditions, describe the various alternative solutions being considered, identify evaluation criteria, and present the preliminary preferred alternative.
