

NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE

Nanticoke Creek Flood Hazard Mapping

The Project: The Long Point Region Conservation Authority (LPRCA) has retained Aquafor Beech Limited to update the floodplain mapping for Nanticoke Creek from Lake Erie in Haldimand County to Thompson Road near the town of Waterford in Norfolk County, a distance of approximately 46 kilometres.

The purpose of this project is to prepare, to current mapping and technical standards, floodplain mapping for this reach of Nanticoke Creek. Accurate flood hazard mapping is required to minimize risk to life and property, support flood and erosion-related response and mitigation planning, as well as land use planning and permitting decisions in at-risk communities across the watershed.

Public Information Centre: A key component of creating new floodplain mapping is consultation with interested stakeholders (public, landowners and agencies). As part of this process, consultation is being undertaken, and your participation is encouraged. A Public Information Centre (PIC) is planned to share the revised flood hazard line, the methodology used for floodplain mapping, and how to submit a question or comment regarding floodplain mapping in your area.
